## Camping

BLMC welcomes applications for camping during the Cup Match holiday only, which is defined as the Wednesday before Emancipation Day to the Sunday following Mary Prince Day (5 days).

Each applicant may apply for one camp site plot only in the following permitted areas: Grey's Cove, Parson's Bay, Lodge Point Park, Clearwater Beach or Turtle Bay.

## Criteria & Requirements

In order to be considered for a camping permit, the applicant must not be in arrears or have a poor credit history with BLMC. Furthermore, any successful camping applications from persons, whose account goes into arrears after booking will have the booking withdrawn and any payments made will be forfeited.

### Successful Applicant Requirements

- Applicants must abide by the laws and health regulations established by the Bermuda Government and the Department of Health.
- The applicant is solely responsible for obtaining all necessary permissions, permits and licenses required.
- The applicant is responsible for delivering the camp site back to BLMC in the same condition it was provided.
- The applicant is responsible for waste management during the camping experience and waste removal from the site unless the applicant has arranged collection with BLMC.

### General Terms & Conditions

- Ticket sales, food sales, beverage sales, product/service sales, Illegal drugs, balloons, generators, bonfires and amplified music are not permitted at any time.
- All barbecuing must be done with proper metal barbecue equipment. Coals and ashes must be extinguished and properly disposed of and may not be buried or disposed of in the ocean.
- All bonfires/campfires require a special permit and permission from BLMC.
- BLMC reserves the right to inspect the permitted site at any time to ensure regulations are being adhered to.
- At no time is a successful applicant permitted to make alterations to BLMC property without advanced written consent from BLMC.
- BLMC reserves the right to charge the successful applicant after the permitted camping period has ended if the camp site plot is not provided back to BLMC in the same condition it was given.
- BLMC accepts no liability for any personal injury or injury to participants and third party vendors, loss or damage to belongings, equipment, decor or belongings of third party suppliers or participants sustained while on property, during, before and after the camping experience.

- BLMC reserves the right to remove any items left after the agreement period is complete and to dispose of the items or charge the successful applicant accordingly for storage.
- BLMC will not sign for or secure any deliveries. If deliveries are made and the successful applicant is not on site, BLMC will not be held liable for items. The same holds true for materials not collected after the camping experience has ended.

## Application Process

All applications for camping are subject to the following process:

1. Review the **Camping Criteria and Process** document
2. Fill out and submit the **Camping Application**
3. Applicants will be contacted via email with application status
4. Payment is submitted upon signing of the **Camping Permit**.

All camping applications must be submitted no later than two weeks prior to the week of Cup Match or risk not being considered.

Please note each individual application for camping will be considered on its own merit. An application for camping must be submitted each year even if the applicant camps yearly.

No application shall be deemed successful unless and until the applicant and BLMC have signed the Camping Permit. No comment by any employee of BLMC or any other circumstance affects this position.
