TERMS AND CONDITIONS

I/We have read the Terms and Conditions below and agree to abide by them should the above Camping Permit Application be approved. I/We agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Bermuda Land Management Corporation from and against the consequences of any claims arising as a result of any personal injury, loss or damage sustained by ourselves or any third parties or their goods and effects whilst on the premises of or within the area known as the Royal Naval Dockyard and/or Southside, Bermuda.

- I understand camping is only permitted over the Cup Match Holiday for a span of 5 days.
- I understand tents can only be erected and must be removed the Sunday following Cup Match.
- I understand the camping fee is \$25.00 per night per plot (1 plot = 3 tents) with a \$50 refundable damage deposit.
- I understand my refundable damage deposit will not be refunded if the site is not kept clean.
- I understand permits are issued on a first come, first served basis and space is limited.
- I understand no wood open fires are permitted. Charcoal, propane or liquid fuel stoves are acceptable within suitable metal containers. Ashes from barbecues should be soaked with salt water and disposed of in waste barrels.
- I understand cooking in tents is prohibited.
- I understand that it is the responsibility of the camping permit holder to ensure that garbage, which accumulates around the campsite, is placed in the dumpster or trash barrels on the camp grounds.
- I understand no dogs or animals are permitted at campsites and that noise must be kept to a minimum.
- I understand, if awarded a permit, the permit must be in the permit holders possession at all times and should be shown to a BLMC officer upon request at any time.
